## <u>Links Gymnastics (Berkshire) Ltd</u> Sick Children Policy - Parents Information

Links Gymnastics will not admit children with infectious diseases i.e.;

- Chicken Pox,
- Measles.
- German Measles,
- Mumps,
- Whooping Cough,
- (Diarrhoea and sickness please allow 48hrs before returning your child to classes at Links Gymnastics).

There may be other infections that are not listed, please inform the Lead Coach for the session on registration and they will decide if your child/children can be admitted.

Links Gymnastics the right to refuse admittance to any child/children that they feel may be too unwell to take part in any activity. Consideration is given to the child, other children and staff always.

In the event of a child becoming unwell during a session/class then the relevant personnel will be informed and in turn, their parent/carer will be contacted for the child to be collected. Failure to collect may result in the child suffering unnecessary distress. We would emphasise the need for the parent/carer to be understanding and respond immediately.
